AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2007 HMA Pavement Scarification & Resurfacing: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Des Moines Asphalt & Paving Co., James D. Gauger, President, \$1,020,685.15.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2007 HMA Pavement Scarification & Resurfacing and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for timely maintenance of residential and arterial streets utilizing surface scarification and hot mix asphalt overlay to improve the surface condition and extend the useful service life of the streets.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$1,020,685.15 Construction Contract (\$1,124,450 City Engineer's Estimate)

Funding Source: 2007-2008 CIP, Page Street-7, Asphaltic Paving Restoration Program, STR003, Various Funding, Being:

- \$650,000 in G. O. Bonds from STR003;
- \$75,000 in G. O. Bonds from Page Street-6, Asphaltic Overlay Program, STR020;
- \$218,516.15 in Tax Increment Funds from Page Street-12, Downtown Area Street Restoration, STR075; and
- \$77,169 in G. O. Bonds from Page Street-29, Neighborhood Infrastructure Rehabilitation Program, STR205

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On May 21, 2007, under Roll Call No. 07-935, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2007 HMA Pavement Scarification & Resurfacing. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2007 HMA Pavement Scarification & Resurfacing, 06-2007-016. Scarification of two (2) inch average depth of asphalt street surfaces with specified milling machine and equipment in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines Public Works Department, all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations within the City of Des Moines:

25th Street from Forest Avenue to Clark Street
Mondamin Avenue from 27th Street to Dead End west

Furnish all labor, materials and equipment necessary to construct a two (2) inch average thickness pavement scarification and HMA surfacing on existing asphaltic street surface; together with other incidental and related work; all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations within the City of Des Moines:

Adams Avenue from 27th Street to ML King Jr. Parkway
Clark Street from 23rd Street to 19th Street

Furnish all labor, materials and equipment necessary to construct a three (3) inch HMA base and one (1) inch HMA surface on existing street surface; together with shouldering and other incidental and related work; all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations within the City of Des Moines:

SW 56th Street from McKinley Avenue to Highway 28.

Eco-Tech Construction, LLC, Grimes, IA - Bid not read because Bidder failed to complete Proposal Attachment Part F Item 2 Contract Compliance Program showing DBE/TSB contacts made prior to the bid.

The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on June 5, 2007.

The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Des Moines Asphalt & Paving Co., James D. Gauger, President, P.O. Box 3365, 5550 NE 22nd Street, Suite 100, Des Moines, IA, 50316 in the amount of \$1,020,685.15, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
