AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of 2007 Community Oriented Policing Methamphetamine Initiative Grant Proposal

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of a Community Oriented Policing Methamphetamine Initiative Grant proposal which would support community policing efforts in preventing the production, use and distribution of methamphetamine.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$412,484.32. There is no match requirement for this grant. The grant period is for two years starting October 1, 2007 through September 30, 2009.

Funding Source: The accounts to implement the grant will be established upon receipt of the grant.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The U.S. Department of Justice through the Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) has established a methamphetamine initiative grant program. The program provides up to \$450,000, without a required local match, to be directed towards multi-jurisdictional activities to combat the manufacture, sale and use of methamphetamine.

The Police Department is proposing to use the grant funding for multi-jurisdictional overtime activities, lab-cleanup, training and equipment.
