AGENDA HEADING:

Resolution authorizing feasibility study and preliminary design of a sanitary sewer from the 3200 block to the 3300 block of Lincoln Avenue.

SYNOPSIS:

Approval of the authorization to proceed with a feasibility study and preliminary design on the assessed sanitary sewer project. The City Council has received a petition requesting the construction of the sanitary sewer.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$30,000 (study and design only)

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On August 20, 2007, by Roll Call 07-1646, the City Council received a petition from the residents along Lincoln Ave in the 3300 and 3200 block requesting the extension of a city sanitary sewer to serve their properties. These houses are currently on septic systems. Staff has determined that there is an existing sanitary sewer in the vicinity of these properties that could be extended. The City Council has a policy of assessing a portion of any sanitary sewer extensions. The alignment of any extension must be determined by the elevations of the existing City sanitary sewer and the individual houses to be served. In order to determine a reasonable cost estimate, a feasibility study and preliminary design based upon field survey must be accomplished. This roll call authorizes the study and preliminary design. After the preliminary design, a preliminary assessment schedule will be formulated and presented to the City Council for approval.
