AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2008 Sewer Televising Program: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as American Hydro Services Inc., Greg Oberhofier, President, \$343,975.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2008 Sewer Televising Program and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for the cleaning and televising of older storm and sanitary sewers to determine their condition prior to lining. The information obtained will be used to evaluate various lining techniques and identify locations where spot sewer repairs will need to be included in the lining contract.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$343,975 Construction Contract (\$377,665 City Engineer's Estimate)

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On October 8, 2007, under Roll Call No. 07-1915, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2008 Sewer Televising Program. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2008 Sewer Televising Program, 07-2008-001. The improvement includes cleaning and televising of approximately 35,000 lineal feet of 8" through 60" sewer; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 478-095/109, at:

- Easement from 63rd St. and Grand Ave. to 56th St. and North Valley Dr.
- Carlisle Rd. from SE 43rd St. to 5,000 feet west

- Capitol Ave. from E. 14th St. to E. 15th St.
- E Marion St. from SE 5th St. to 800 feet east
- Boyd St. from E 13th St. to E. 14th St.

- Grandview Ave. from E 13th St. to E 14th St.
- Grand Ave. from Des Moines River to 3rd St.
- 3rd St. from Grand Ave. to Watson Powell Jr. Way
- Watson Powell Jr. Way from 3rd St. to 7th St.
- 7th St. from Watson Powell Jr. Way to Park St.
- Park St. from 7th St. to 9th St.
- Walnut St. from Des Moines River to 10th St.
- 9th St. from Walnut St. to Grand Ave.
- Grand Ave. from 9th St. to 10th St.
- E Grand Ave. from E 6th St. to east 1000 block
- E Walnut St from E 4th St. to E 7th St.
- E Court Ave. from Des Moines River to E 7th St.
- Muskogee Ave. from River Oaks Dr. to 200 feet south
- Clinton Ave. from 16th St. to 200 feet east
- Amick Ave. from 4500 block to 200 feet east
- 2800 block Beaver Ave. to 4000 block of Adams Ave.
- SE 6th St. and Trowbridge St. to 200 feet north

- Cummins Pkwy. from Forest Ave. to Carpenter Ave.
- 42nd St. from Aurora Ave. to 500 feet north.

The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on October 23, 2007.

The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by American Hydro Services Inc., Greg Oberhofier, President, 4235 Green Bay Road, Suite 213, Kenosha, WI, 53144 in the amount of \$343,975, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
