AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of grant agreements with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for funding of the City's 2008 HUD Consolidated Plan.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of grant agreements by and between HUD and the City of Des Moines, whereby the City will receive Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME), and Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) funding (grant awards) for implementation of the 2008 HUD Consolidated Plan for the period of January 1, 2008, to December 31, 2008.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On November 19, 2007, by Roll Call No. 07-2231, the City Council authorized and directed the City Manager to submit the 2008 HUD Consolidated Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. HUD has now forwarded grant agreements for CDBG, HOME, and ESG funds for funding of the City's 2008 HUD Consolidated Plan. The grant agreements require Council approval and the Mayor's signature.
