## **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approval of Amendment No. 1 to the FY2006 Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program (LETPP) Grant

## SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Amendment No. 1 to the original grant agreement which changes the performance period of the FY2006-LEIN5-05 Grant. The approved performance period was from August 31, 2006 through March 31, 2008 and now has a new end date of December 31, 2008. The change in the end date will allow all work to be completed and all grant funds expended. There are no other changes to the grant other than the performance period end date.

## **FISCAL IMPACT:**

<u>Amount</u>: The grant award from the State of Iowa Homeland Security and Emergency Management Division was \$306,305.50. There was no requirement for a local match.

<u>Funding Source</u>: Grant proceeds was deposited into SP751, POL980520, LETPP Grant (Page 284, Adopted Budget Fiscal Year Ending 2009).

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The grant award is administered by the City of Des Moines for the 20 county area, referred to as Law Enforcement Intelligence Network (LEIN) Region 5. The Des Moines Police Department was selected as one of six lead agencies throughout the State of Iowa to administer Federal Homeland Security Funds through LETPP. This is a continuation of a collaborative effort coordinated with other local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies to share and analyze terrorism related intelligence data.
