AGENDA HEADING:

Authorizing the Des Moines Municipal Housing Agency (DMMHA) to negotiate with Home Opportunities Made Easy, Inc (HOME Inc.) for the disposition sale of 819 Hartford Avenue.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend authorization for DMMHA to negotiate with HOME Inc. for the disposition sale of 819 Hartford Avenue.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$66,750 (sale price)

Funding Source: FY 2007-08 Operating Budget, Public Housing, pg. 173, SP350 HSG020000.

Future revenue derived from the sale of these properties will be allocated accordingly:

- 75% Affordable Housing Endowment Fund
- 25% Physical Improvements to existing Manors

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On August 19, 2003, the Housing Services Department received approval for its application to dispose of 394 Public Housing units at fair market value via a public bid. Where there are commensurate public benefits, according to federal regulations, sales can be negotiated with a specific buyer.

HOME, Inc., an Iowa nonprofit corporation, has a long history of providing affordable housing in the City of Des Moines while meeting the requirements of federally funded housing programs. It has the ability to meet the requirements of DMMHA's disposition plan. HOME, Inc. intends to rehab and sell this property for Affordable Homeownership for households earning less than 80% of median income guidelines.
