The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the High Street Realignment - 10th Street to 14th Street - Phase 1, 06-2008-004. The improvement includes clearing and grubbing, pavement removal and replacement, sidewalk removal and replacement, excavation, storm sewer, hydrant relocation, traffic signals, pavement markings, construction survey, sodding and site restoration; all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File Nos. 490-10/50 at High Street from 10th Street to 12th Street, Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated construction cost is \$680,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the City Engineer's Office.
