AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2008 Expanded Street Resurfacing Program - Contract 2: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Grimes Asphalt & Paving Corp., J M Yonker, President, \$1,500,141.60.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2008 Expanded Street Resurfacing Program -Contract 2 and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for partial and full depth patching, surface milling, and hot mix asphalt (HMA) overlay of arterial and residential streets citywide. The project addresses citizen concerns regarding the condition of city streets by preserving deteriorating infrastructure.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On June 23, 2008, under Roll Call No. 08-1094, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2008 Expanded Street Resurfacing Program - Contract 2. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2008 Expanded Street Resurfacing Program - Contract 2, 06-2008-018. The improvement includes scarification of existing asphalt streets, furnishing and placing pavement markings, and other incidental items; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plans File Nos. 490-150/170, at the following locations within the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

- •30th Street from Forest Avenue to Hickman Road
- •Urbandale Avenue from 34th Street to Beaver Avenue
- •6th Avenue from Birdland Drive to Euclid Avenue
- •Guthrie Avenue from Delaware Avenue to E 23rd Street

•Guthrie Avenue from Dixon Street to Delaware Avenue •Maury Street from SE 14th Street to E 22nd Street •Maury Street from SE 6th Street to SE 14th Street.

The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on July 15, 2008.

The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of the improvement was submitted by Grimes Asphalt & Paving Corp., J M Yonker, President, 12021 NW 54th Avenue, Grimes, IA, 50111 in the amount of \$1,500,141.60, and the bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for the improvement.
