AGENDA HEADING:

Approving an increase in an annual concrete work contract.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval to increase the amount of an existing annual concrete work contract from \$50,000 to \$115,000.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$65,000

<u>Funding Source:</u> 2008-2009 CIP, page 15, PKS137, CP040PKS990000, Capital Projects/Neighborhood Park Improvements.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The original annual contract amount for the Parks and Recreation annual concrete work contract was \$50,000. The addition of a \$22,000 sidewalk replacement project along University Avenue bordering the Glendale Cemetery has caused the depletion of the available funding. Additional concrete work (\$65,000) is needed for the remainder of FY 2009 for signage, trails, and other sidewalk replacement projects that do not exceed \$15,000.
