AGENDA HEADING:

Approving CDBG Housing Disaster Recovery Fund Contract.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the CDBG Housing Disaster Recovery Fund Contract with the Iowa Department of Economic Development for homeowners for down payment assistance, housing repair/rehabilitation, interim mortgage assistance, and the 15% local match required by FEMA for Home Buyouts.

FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount</u>: \$588,507

<u>Funding Sources</u>: The Iowa Department of Economic Development is providing funding for the CDBG Housing Disaster Recovery Fund. No city matching funds are required.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Iowa Department of Economic Development has announced a program to assist homeowners with down payment assistance, housing repair/rehabilitation, interim mortgage assistance, and a 15% local match required by FEMA for Home Buyouts. For this program, the City of Des Moines has been allocated \$1,152,745. If the initial \$588,507 is expended, additional funding up to \$1,152,745 may be allocated.

This is the first of three rounds of assistance the City of Des Moines anticipates receiving from the State of Iowa and CDBG Disaster funding. For this round of funding Des Moines is eligible for 3.29% of the funding available. Statewide there is \$20 million available for the Jumpstart Housing Assistance Program, \$20 million available for Jumpstart Small Business Assistance, \$10 million CDBG Supplemental Funds – Business, and \$35 million CDBG Supplemental Funds – Housing.
