#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Authorization to acquire necessary right-of-way for the Southeast 14<sup>th</sup> Street and East Indianola Avenue Intersection Improvement Project by gift, negotiation, or eminent domain.

### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend authorization to acquire necessary right-of-way for the Southeast 14<sup>th</sup> Street and East Indianola Avenue Intersection Improvement Project. This action is required by Iowa law before the City can initiate the right-of-way acquisition process under eminent domain.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

<u>Amount</u>: To be determined by an independent appraiser after design is complete and the right-of-way acquisition limits have been determined.

<u>Funding Source</u>: Various funding sources as follows:

- \$300,000 Iowa DOT Traffic Safety Improvement Funds
- \$50,000 2008-09 CIP, Page Street-14, East Indianola Avenue Widening S.E. 14<sup>th</sup> to Army Post Road, STR213, G.O. Bonds

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The City of Des Moines is currently designing and acquiring property for the widening of E Indianola Avenue from E 14<sup>th</sup> Street to SE 16<sup>th</sup> Court. As part of the project development for the Indianola Avenue Widening, additional intersection improvements on SE 14<sup>th</sup> Street were identified. These improvements include widening SE 14<sup>th</sup> Street to provide dual northbound left turn lanes. The SE 14<sup>th</sup> Street project will be funded with \$300,000 of Traffic Safety Improvement Program Funds and \$50,000 of G.O. Bonds. The construction will begin in 2009 and be coordinated with the Indianola Avenue Widening project. In order to widen SE 14<sup>th</sup> Street, a total of four-partial acquisitions and temporary construction easements will be required. The fair market value of the property interests to be acquired will be determined by an independent appraisal and the fair market values will be submitted to the City Council or the City Manager for approval, as applicable, prior to the commencement of negotiations.
