AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of the Employee Interchange Agreement contract.

SYNOPSIS:

The Polk County Sheriff has requested that a Des Moines Police Lieutenant be assigned to the Sheriff's Office. Polk County will reimburse the City for all costs and assume liability for this employee. Chapter 28D of the Code of Iowa allows for such agreements and a contract has been negotiated.

Funding Source: All costs will be reimbursed by Polk County. Expenses and off-setting revenue will be posted to FY2009/2010 Operating Budget, Page 257, GE001; POL010100.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Last month the Polk County Sheriff requested that Des Moines Police Lieutenant Allan Tunks be assigned to the Sheriff's Office to be in charge of their detective operation. Lieutenant Tunks has extensive training and experience in major crimes and investigations. His assignment would enhance area law enforcement and provide an opportunity for Des Moines and Polk County to continue a high level of cooperation.

Lieutenant Tunks would continue to be a City employee. He would be compensated as Chief of Investigations-Second Deputy Sheriff. Polk County would reimburse the City of Des Moines for the cost of all salary and benefits and assume liability for him. The salary would be \$98,265 plus benefits. The Employee Interchange Agreement would be for twenty-four (24) months with an option for an additional twenty-four (24) months.

A contract, in accordance with Chapter 28D of the Code of Iowa, has been negotiated. Approval of the contract is recommended.
