# **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The replacement of the Easton Boulevard Bridge over Four Mile Creek was identified as a high priority project in the 2007 City-Wide Bridge and Structure Evaluation. A Request for Proposal (RFP) for these professional services was sent to seven consultants and posted on the City's web site. Eight proposals were received in response to the RFP. A selection committee composed of representatives from Public Works, Traffic & Transportation, and Engineering rated the proposals. Calhoun-Burns and Associates was the selection of the committee based on their qualifications, defined approach to this project, and established performance with the City.

Staff has negotiated a Professional Services Agreement with Calhoun-Burns and Associates, for hourly rates not to exceed \$155,600, to provide evaluation, design, and construction phase services.
