ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

A provision of HUD's 2006 Appropriations Act changed the requirement under the law for housing authorities in the State of Iowa to include a resident/recipient on their governing board.

In place of the requirement to have a resident/recipient on the governing board, housing authorities are required to establish a Resident Advisory Board which meets at least quarterly, that consists of not less than 6 residents of public housing or recipients of section 8 assistance to provide advice and comment to the public housing agency or other administering entity on issues related to public housing and Section 8.

The Des Moines Municipal Housing Agency does have a Resident Advisory Board that meets this requirement.
