AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of FY 2008-09 Annual Right-of-Way Management Fee.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2008-09 annual management fee in the amount of 0.41 cents per equivalent lineal foot (with a minimum fee of \$100) for the Right-of-Way (ROW) Management Program, which is documented in the Supplemental Right-of-Way Budget information attached to the Roll Call.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$96,912 (revenue), \$4,211 increase from prior year

<u>Funding Source</u>: \$84,140 from right-of-way non-city utility users and \$12,772 from City of Des Moines sewer enterprise funds.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The City Engineer has calculated and hereby submits for City Council consideration the FY 2008-09 annual management fee in the amount of 0.41 cents per equivalent lineal foot of ROW usage (or 0.41 cents per 100 equivalent linear feet). This is a slight increase from last year's FY2007-08 Annual Management fee of .40 cents per equivalent linear foot. This fee is charged to all ROW users on the basis of their reported or estimated usage of City ROW as required by Section 102-711 of the City Code. Right-of-way users have utilities or other facilities in the public rights-of-way, either underground or overhead. Program costs that can be attributed to specific users (allocable costs) are recovered through permit fees, which are specified in a separate fee schedule and are charged to those users when they obtain a permit for construction. Program costs that cannot be attributed to specific users (non – allocable) are recovered through an annual management fee, which is charged to all users, including the City, based on their pro-rata occupancy of City ROW. This 0.41-cent fee is used to recover these non-allocable costs.

All users of City right-of-way are required to report to the City Engineer the amount of equipment they own and operate in the City ROW and update it on an annual basis. The 2008-2009 total equivalent lineal footage of all ROW users is 23,670,235 equivalent lineal feet. The amount of the annual management fee charged to each user is then calculated based on their reported, estimated usage and the 0.41 cent fee.
