AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of 2010 Governor’s Traffic Safety Bureau Section (GTSB) 410 Alcohol-Impaired Driving Incentive Grant Application

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the 2010 GTSB Section 410 Grant Application for five (5) in-car video cameras and five (5) portable breath testers (PBT’s). This grant is a traffic enforcement grant that the Des Moines Police Department has received since 1988.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$24,750

Funding Source: National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), Public Law 105-178, Section 410. 2008-2009 Operating Budget, Page 284, Special Revenue Funds, SP751. An organizational code will be assigned once award notice has been received.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The grant application provides \$24,750 for the Police Department to fund the following:

- Five in-car video cameras to be installed in Traffic Section Patrol Vehicles
- Five portable breath testers (PBT’s)

The grant period is from October 01, 2009 through September 30, 2010. There is no match for this grant.
