AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of contract with Sprint Solutions, Inc. for cell phone services.

SYNOPSIS:

At its January 26, 2009 meeting, the City Council approved Sprint Solutions as the low responsible bidder for the provision of cell phone services. This action presents the resulting contract for approval. It has a two-year initial term with three possible annual renewals following.

FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount</u>: \$286,624 estimated annual cost of this agreement (depends on number of phones and smart phones actually used).

Funding Source: Various department operating budgets

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Current contracts with Sprint Solutions and U.S. Cellular have expired. Bids were solicited from Sprint Solutions, U.S. Cellular, Verizon, T-Mobile and AT&T for cellular service based on a 24 month contract. All five vendors responded to the City's request and offered proposals which were reviewed by representatives from Legal, Risk Management, Purchasing and IT. Sprint Solutions meets all minimum requirements as identified in the list of needs for the City and was the lowest bidder.
