AGENDA HEADING:

First reading and waiver of readings of an Ordinance amending Chapter 78 regarding peddlers, transient merchants and solicitors to allow enforcement through civil means, in addition to a criminal citation.

SYNOPSIS:

The proposed ordinance adds Section 78-11 to Chapter 78 to authorize enforcement of violations of the regulations applicable to peddlers, transient merchants and solicitors; to be prosecuted either as a misdemeanor or as a civil infraction.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Chapter 78 of the City Code contains the regulations applicable to peddlers, transient merchants and parties soliciting contributions of funds (solicitors). A violation of Chapter 78 can clearly be prosecuted as a misdemeanor, but the existing language in Chapter 78 does not authorize such a violation to be prosecuted as a civil infraction. The proposed ordinance authorizes the additional remedy of prosecution, of any violation of Chapter 78, as a civil infraction.
