AGENDA HEADING:

Amending Chapter 114 of the Municipal Code regarding traffic regulation changes as follows:

- A. Prohibiting left turns from private driveway onto East Diehl Avenue.
- B. Parking Restriction to facilitate Solid Waste collection—west side of SE 4th Street from East Philip Street to East McKinley Avenue.
- C. Code revisions for field adjustments to parking signs and meters.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Traffic and Transportation Division staff recommendations for minor parking adjustments, including first reading of the Ordinance regarding the traffic regulation changes.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: Minor costs for signing modifications.

Funding Source: 2009-2010 Operating Budget, Page 93, Engineering Department Traffic & Transportation - Sign Installation and Maintenance, ENG100413.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- A. At the May 4, 2009 Council meeting, by Roll Call 09-764, the City Council approved a rezoning request from Menards to allow them to expand their store on SE 14th Street, with a condition that vehicles exiting the Menards site northbound through a private driveway be prohibited from turning left onto East Diehl Avenue. The following ordinance change is necessary to implement this left-turn restriction.

Sec. 114-320.01. Prohibited left turns.

(13) At the intersection of East Diehl Avenue and a private driveway 220 feet west of Southeast Fourteenth Street, prohibiting left turns northbound from the driveway to East Diehl Avenue.

- B. The Traffic and Transportation Division recommends that parking be restricted to one side of SE 4th Street on Thursdays to facilitate solid waste collection services. The following revision to the Municipal Code is necessary to place this restriction into effect.

Sec. 114-2624. Southeast Fourth Street—East Vine Street to East Army Post Road.

Southeast Fourth Street, on the west side, from East Philip Street to East McKinley Avenue, no parking Thursdays, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

- C. During a review of the traffic code, Traffic and Transportation Division staff identified several code revisions that are needed due to field adjustments that have been made to the placement of parking signs and/or meters. The following changes are necessary to adjust the Municipal Code to match the field conditions.

Sec. 114-3544.5. East Ovid Avenue—East Forty-second Street to east city limits.

East Ovid Avenue, on the north side, from East Forty-second Street to East Forty-third Street, no parking any time.

Sec. 114-2604. Third Street--Court Avenue to Walnut Street.

Third Street, on the east side, from Court Avenue to a point ~~245~~ 65 feet north thereof, no parking any time.

Third Street, on the east side, from a point 140 feet north of Court Avenue to a point ~~245~~ 105 feet north thereof, no parking any time.

Third Street, on the east side, from a point 65 feet north of Court Avenue to a point 75 feet north thereof, no parking 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Third Street, on the east side, from a point 65 feet north of Court Avenue to a point 80 feet north thereof, taxicab stand 6:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m.

Sec. 114-2759. Fifteenth Street--Walnut Street to Ingersoll Avenue.

~~Fifteenth Street, on both sides, from Grand Avenue to a point 150 feet north thereof, two hour parking 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.~~

Fifteenth Street, on the west side, from Grand Avenue to a point 25 feet north thereof, no parking anytime.

Fifteenth Street, on the west side, from Ingersoll Avenue to a point ~~30~~ 20 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

Sec. 114-2760. Fifteenth Street--Ingersoll Avenue to dead end north of Shawnee Avenue.

Fifteenth Street, on the west side, from ~~a point 75 feet south of~~ Ingersoll Avenue to a point 120 feet north of Ingersoll Avenue, no parking any time.

Sec. 114-4000. Fifteenth Street—Locust Street to ~~Grand~~ Ingersoll Avenue.

~~Fifteenth Street, on the west side, from Grand Avenue to a point 75 feet north thereof, ten hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.~~

~~Fifteenth Street, on the west side, from a point 175 feet north to a point 30 feet south of Ingersoll Avenue, ten hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.~~

~~Fifteenth Street, on the east side, from Grand Avenue to a point 125 feet north thereof, ten hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.~~

Fifteenth Street, on the west side, from a point 25 feet north of Grand Avenue to a point 60 feet north thereof, ten hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Fifteenth Street, on the west side, from a point 185 feet north of Grand Avenue to a point 46 feet north thereof, ten hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Fifteenth Street, on the east side, from a point 40 feet north of Grand Avenue to a point 85 feet north thereof, ten hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
