AGENDA HEADING:

Approval to upgrade 1,320 Microsoft Enterprise Agreement Standard Core Client Access Licenses (CALs) to Microsoft Enterprise CALs in the amount of \$108,525.12, to Insight Public Sector, 3480 Lotus Dr, Plano, TX 75075.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval to upgrade 1,320 Microsoft Enterprise Agreement Standard Core Client Access Licenses to Microsoft Enterprise CALs in the amount of \$108,525.12. The upgrade will add functionality to satisfy business needs for unified communications, collaboration, enterprise content management and search, security, compliance, and Information Technology administration.

The license counts exist on the Microsoft Enterprise Agreement entered into on May 1, 2007 and on subsequent annual license true-ups pursuant to State of Iowa Master Contract # CT2792 covering both the Microsoft Select Agreement CT2792 and Microsoft Enterprise Agreement CT2795 with Insight Public Sector, Inc. previously known as Software Spectrum, Inc. a division of Insight, Inc., 3480 Lotus Dr, Plano, TX 75075.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$108,525.12

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The upgrade to Enterprise CALs will satisfy technology requirements for a number of enterprise-wide initiatives this calendar year and the next fiscal year.

In July of this year Microsoft will be breaking up the Office Communication Server (OCS) Enterprise CAL into two pieces, one remaining as the OCS Enterprise CAL and a new one called the Voice CAL. All the voice functionality in OCS will be removed from the OCS license, and will be part of the Voice CAL license. By upgrading to the Enterprise CAL before July 1st we will be grandfathered-in thus avoiding the need to purchase this CAL separately.
