AGENDA HEADING:

Approval for the City's Purchasing Division to issue blanket purchase orders for miscellaneous building materials and supplies to be purchased during Fiscal Year 2010 (FY10) by the Department of Public Works.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval for the City's Purchasing Agent to issue blanket purchase orders for miscellaneous building materials and supplies to metro area Home Depot stores, which is under state contract.

The Department of Public Works utilizes building materials and supplies for its various divisions.
