# **AGENDA HEADING:**

Hold hearing for the conveyance of a vacated segment of the east/west alley between SE 8<sup>th</sup> Street and SE 9<sup>th</sup> Street between East Railroad Avenue and Vale Street to Larry Parsons for \$100.

### SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the conveyance of a vacated segment of the east/west alley between SE 8<sup>th</sup> Street and SE 9<sup>th</sup> Street between East Railroad Avenue and Vale Street to Larry Parsons, 806 E Railroad Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa 50309, for \$100. This action is required by Iowa law prior to making a final determination on the proposed sale by resolution. There is no current or anticipated public need for this property. The sale of this property will help reduce the City's ownership of excess land and will allow Larry Parsons to expand the rear yard of his property.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$100 (Revenue)

<u>Funding Source</u>: Sale proceeds will be deposited into the Property Maintenance Endowment Fund, SP767, ENG980500. The first \$175,000 of annual proceeds to the Property Maintenance Endowment Fund will be returned to the General Fund (GE001, ENG040700) to offset the operating budget of the Engineering – Real Estate Division.

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

On December 21, 1998, by Roll Call No. 98-3928 (Ordinance No. 13,665), the City Council vacated the east/west alley and the north/south alley between 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> Streets, north of Railroad Avenue and south of Vale Street, subject to reservation of easements for all utilities now in place with the right-of-entry for servicing same.

The property to be conveyed is the last section of this east/west alley under City ownership and is currently unaccessible by the City for maintenance. The conveyance of this property will help reduce the City's ownership of excess land and will also eliminate the City's maintenance liability for this property. Larry Parsons has submitted an offer of \$100 to purchase the property for residential yard expansion, which is equal to the estimated fair market value.
