AGENDA HEADING:

Requesting approval of an extension granted by The U.S Department of Justice and the State of Iowa Office of Drug Control Policy for the 2006 Project Safe Neighborhoods Anti-Gang Initiative Grant Award to June 30, 2010.

SYNOPSIS:

Through the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Southern District of Iowa, the Police Department has applied for and has been awarded a Project Safe Neighborhoods Anti-Gang Initiative Grant. An extension was requested and granted to spend the remaining \$544 for gang related overtime. The initial grant amount was \$69,894.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Project Safe Neighborhoods 2006 Anti-Gang Initiative provides funding to support new and expanded anti-gang prevention and enforcement efforts. This program is being administered through the State of Iowa, Office of Drug Control Policy for the U.S. Department of Justice. The grant was for a three-year period from July 01, 2006 through June 30, 2009.

An extension was granted with a new ending date of June 30, 2010.
