### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approving Professional Services Supplemental Agreement No. 1 with Snyder & Associates, Inc. for additional design services for the 2009 Sewer Repair Contract 1, not to exceed \$26,672.

#### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of the Professional Services Supplemental Agreement No. 1 with Snyder & Associates, David Moeller, President, 2727 S.W. Snyder Boulevard, Ankeny, IA, 50023, for additional design services for 2009 Sewer Repair Contract 1 not to exceed \$26,672.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On May 4, 2009, by Roll Call No. 09-714, City Council approved a professional services agreement with Snyder & Associates to provide design and construction administration services for the 2009 Sewer Repair Contract 1 Project. Since the approval of this agreement, additional unforeseen design issues have arisen that require additional design work by the consultant. Additional work includes the design of larger intakes and a complete culvert replacement at the River Oak Drive location to increase storm water system capacity; the design of repairs for the Capitol Avenue location, which includes sanitary sewer repairs; and additional geotechnical investigation, including additional soil borings. Staff recommends approving the Professional Services Supplemental Agreement No. 1 with Snyder & Associates.
