ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Brent Curtis (NR-0) Senior Police Officer, to Maitland, FL, from April 28 – May 8, 2010 (\$4,433.50), to attend the 2010 IACIS BASIC Conference. The program will provide certification in computer forensics. Costs associated with the training will be reimbursed by the State of Iowa.

Kenneth Robinson (NR-0) Senior Police Officer, to Lansing, MI, from April 25 – May 1, 2010 (\$1,630), to attend Patrol Rifle Instructor School. The course will provide certification as a Patrol Rifle Instructor.

The amount budgeted for travel in Fiscal Year (FY) 2010 is \$629,436. The amount expended for travel in FY 2010, as of December 14, 2009, is \$182,229.
