AGENDA HEADING:

Amendment to intergovernmental agreement for the promotion of tourism and convention activities in the greater Des Moines area.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of an amendment to the intergovernmental agreement for the promotion of tourism and convention activities in the greater Des Moines area in cooperation with Polk County and the cities of Altoona, Ankeny, Clive, Grimes, Johnston, Perry, Pleasant Hill, Urbandale, West Des Moines and Windsor Heights. The proposed amendment changes the method by which members are appointed to the Joint Board.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

An April, 1985 agreement between Des Moines, Altoona, Ankeny, Clive, Grimes, Johnston, Perry, Pleasant Hill, Urbandale, West Des Moines, Windsor Heights and Polk County approved the use of 2/7 of Hotel/Motel tax receipts by the Convention and Visitor's Bureau (CVB) to promote tourism and convention activities in the greater Des Moines area. Section V.A of this agreement specified that the Mayors of each municipality would serve on the Joint Board or would appoint a designee. Section VII.D specifies that a vote of the member cities would elect three members to serve on the Board in the event that the CVB was no longer providing promotion services.

The revised language provides that each city's representative on the Joint Board will be appointed by resolution of their respective City Councils. Similar revised language addresses the appointment of the County representative. The new language reflects the way most appointments have actually been made in the past.
