AGENDA HEADING:

Hold hearing on the intent to acquire property for recreational trail purposes and authorize acquisition of the necessary property interests thereof for the Des Moines and Raccoon Rivers Birdland Levee Project by gift, negotiation, or eminent domain.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend Council approval on the intent to acquire property for recreational trail purposes and authorize acquisition of the necessary property interests thereof for the Des Moines and Raccoon Rivers Birdland Levee Project by gift, negotiation, or eminent domain. This action is required by Iowa law before the City can initiate the acquisition of property under eminent domain for the purpose of constructing recreation trails. The trail will be located on property that will be acquired for the primary purpose of reconstructing and maintaining the Birdland Levee. No additional property acquisition costs will be associated with this action, but it is required before the City can include a secondary use of the property for recreation trail purposes, if eminent domain is necessary.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On November 23, 2009, by Roll Call No. 09-2143, the City Council approved plans for construction of a multi-use trail connection to McHenry Park as part of the Des Moines and Raccoon Rivers Project ("the Project"), which proposed recreational trail is further described as follows:

A 12 foot wide multipurpose recreational trail approximately 2,200 feet long from the Neal Smith Trail west of 6^{th} Avenue atop the Birdland Levee through Riverview (Kiwanis Nature Island) to McHenry Park.

Under the provisions of Chapter 6B of the Iowa Code, a governmental body which proposes to acquire property under power of eminent domain for recreational trail purposes is required to give notice of a proposed resolution, motion, or other document authorizing acquisition of property by eminent domain to each property owner, contract purchaser of record and any tenant known to be occupying the properties that may be acquired in whole or in part for the recreational trail prior to the date of the

meeting at which such proposed authorization will be considered. (See Section 6B.2D of the Iowa Code.)

The City has mailed notice regarding the proposed resolution authorizing acquisition of property for recreational trail purposes for this Project as required by law. Before further proceeding with the acquisition for recreational trail, the City must (a) hold a public hearing, giving affected persons the opportunity to attend the hearing and present their views and objections regarding the proposed acquisition of private property for the recreational trail portion of the project by gift, negotiation or eminent domain; and (b) adopt a resolution to authorize acquisition of private property for the recreational trail portion of the project by eminent domain.
