IDED has awarded the seven contracts (grants) referenced above totaling \$21,715,460 to the City of Des Moines These grants have been approved by the City Council and the Mayor authorized to execute the contracts on behalf of the City.

The City Council has awarded construction contracts associated with 08-DRI-006 and 007. Engineering Department Staff are working with IDED Staff to seek reimbursement from IDED for construction costs to date. IDED reimbursement forms and other documents required signature by the authorized representative of the City, which is the Mayor.
