AGENDA HEADING:

Approving compensation agreement for relocation of water utility facilities in connection with the Des Moines and Raccoon Rivers – Birdland Levee Project.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Compensation Agreement for Relocation of Water Utility Facilities in Connection with the Des Moines and Raccoon Rivers Project that provides reimbursement to Des Moines Water Works for relocation of water mains identified in conflict with the Birdland levee project.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$363,715

Funding Source: 2009/10 CIP, Flood Protection System Improvements, Page Storm Water

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On October 12, 2009, by Roll Call No. 09-1833, the City Council approved the Project Partnership Agreement (PPA) between the City and the Department of the Army for Construction of the Des Moines and Raccoon Rivers Project. The PPA includes the financial obligations and work related responsibilities of the Corps of Engineers and the City for the Birdland levee project. In accordance with the PPA, the City is responsible for acquiring all lands, easements, rights-of-way, and relocations required for the project. This responsibility includes relocation of utilities. The City costs are related to the levee and will be credited toward the required 35% local share for the flood damage reduction costs.

The Corps of Engineers identified utilities in conflict with the flood reduction features that must be relocated, including the following water lines: the existing water mains in 6th Avenue in the area of the levee north of the bridge over the Des Moines River, the 16" water main currently located in Guthrie Avenue between 2nd Avenue and Saylor Road and the water service to the Birdland Park Shelter at Guthrie Avenue and Saylor Road. The existing water mains within the right-of-way of 6th Avenue will be relocated within the right-of-way of 6th Avenue. The 16" water main generally within the right-of-way of Guthrie Avenue will be relocated into Birdland Park, primarily within Birdland Drive (a park road), and along Saylor Road within Union Park outside the area needed for flood protection. The water service for the Birdland Park Shelter will be relocated to the east to avoid crossing the levee.

The compensation agreement provides that Des Moines Water Works (DMWW) will design and construct the relocated water lines and that following construction, the City will hold a public hearing to convey an easement to DMWW where the water mains are located within City Park property. DMWW will be reimbursed by the City for the construction costs to relocate the 16" water mains and the water service to the Birdland Park Shelter. DMWW is responsible for costs associated with relocation of the 12" mains in 6th Avenue and work not required by the City relocations. The anticipated City cost of \$363,715 is based on the bids received by DMWW. If construction costs exceed this amount, the City will be responsible for increased costs associated with the relocation of the 16" water mains and the water service to the Birdland Park Shelter. The Parks and Recreation Board has approved the plans prepared by Des Moines Water Works and approved the proposal to grant an easement for the water main within Birdland and Union Parks.
