AGENDA HEADING:

Resolution approving the Olive Street Brickstones, L.L.C. application for Enterprise Zone benefits for a housing project in the City of Des Moines.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the application as follows: Olive Street Brickstones, L.L.C., Paul Koester, President, 3050 S.E. Enterprise Drive, Grimes, Iowa 50111, for Enterprise Zone benefits for a \$3.6 M project constructing 21 apartment units at 18th Street and Olive Avenue in the Drake Park/Sherman Hill/Woodland Heights Enterprise Zone.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$120,327 Investment Tax Credit; \$40,000 Sales Tax Refund

<u>Funding Source:</u> Funded by the State of Iowa Enterprise Zone program, which are State of Iowa tax credits and have no impact on the general fund of the City of Des Moines.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Olive Street Brownstones, L.L.C. project will contribute affordable one and two bedroom units to the community, and will include amenities such as private entrances, garden walk-up patios, a computer room, elevator and central laundry facilities. The project will be constructed in compliance with the Iowa Department of Economic Development's "Green Streets" requirements and will resemble the Woodland Avenue Brickstones project constructed at 1500 Woodland Avenue in 2003.
