ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

For the meeting on March 22, 2010, staff will recommend Municipal Housing Governing Board approval of the five-year and one-year Public Housing Agency Plans to be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). It is a regulatory requirement of the Capital Fund Program to complete the application process with an environment review of proposed work. Community Development Department staff conducts the environmental review and completes the subsequent "Request for the Release of Funds" form for submission to HUD. This action directs the Mayor to sign the Environmental Certification and the Request for Release of Funds and directs the Housing Services Director to submit the same to the Kansas City HUD Field Office.
