AGENDA HEADING:

Approving and authorizing the execution of Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) Preconstruction Agreement for the Deans Lake Outfall along the Union Pacific Railroad to Deans Lake Phase 2 Project.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Preconstruction Agreement between the City of Des Moines and the IDOT for the Deans Lake Phase 2 Storm Sewer Outlet in association with I-235 reconstruction. Approval of this agreement will allow construction of the project, estimated at \$4,765,667.50. The IDOT will bid the projects and perform contract administration, while the City of Des Moines will share cost with IDOT to provide a consultant to perform construction inspection, traffic control inspection, and construction administration services for this project.

FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount</u>: \$4,765,667.50

Funding Source: Various funding being:

- \$2,335,177 for storm sewer outlet and enhancements, 2010-11 CIP, Page Street-27, I-235 Storm and Sanitary Sewer Improvements, STR197
- \$2,430,490.50 for street and signal work, IDOT.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The IDOT will initially pay all costs associated with this project. The project is included under the I-235 Predesign Agreement between the City and IDOT (Agreement No. 2001-P-028, dated October 9, 2000). Under said agreement, the City shall repay the IDOT a percentage of storm sewer outlet costs based upon the percentage of drainage area for I-235 and the City. The storm sewer enhanced capacity shall be 100% City cost. The City has made one repayment in June 2008 and the IDOT has agreed to allow the City to delay the final two payments until June 2010 and June 2011.

The Preconstruction Agreement for Deans Lake Phase 2 Storm Sewer Outlet project has been negotiated with IDOT to identify the responsibilities of IDOT and the City regarding the administration, funding, and implementation of the project construction, as well as future maintenance responsibility of City facilities. Construction is expected to begin September 2010 and extend through the 2011 construction season. The general alignment of the storm sewer extends from the south side of I-235 at Ure Street southerly to University Avenue, then westerly to Union Pacific railroad tracks, and then southerly along the abandoned railroad right-of-way to Deans Lake.
