AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: Riverwalk - North of Armory Building - Receiving bids, (5-11-10), and Setting date of hearing, (5-24-10). (Construction Estimate - \$1,386,901).

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. In 2009, the Iowa State Legislature allocated \$750,000 for the Principal Riverwalk to be administered through the Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) as State Recreational Trails project funding. The project will include reconstruction of the floodwall and sidewalk on the west side of the Armory Building, construction of the final trail connections on the east end of the Center Street Bridge, as well as construction of the Riverwalk sidewalk along Robert D. Ray Drive, and resurfacing of the Armory Parking lot.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$1,386,901 City Engineer's Estimate

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2010-2011 CIP, Page Park-21, Principal Riverwalk, PKS162, Being: IDOT State Recreational Trails funding for 75% of construction, not to exceed \$750,000, with the remaining \$636,901 in Storm Water Utility Funds.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

In 2009, the Iowa State Legislature allocated \$750,000 for the Principal Riverwalk. These funds are being administered through the IDOT as State Recreational Trails project funding. The project will include reconstruction of the floodwall and sidewalk on the west side of the Armory Building, construction of the final trail connections on the east end of the Center Street Bridge, as well as construction of the Riverwalk sidewalk along Robert D. Ray Drive, and resurfacing of the Armory Parking lot.

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Riverwalk - North of Armory Building, 11-2010-011. The improvement includes removal and reconstruction of approximately 507 LF of PCC floodwall between the Brenton Skating Plaza and the newly constructed Center Street Bridge; and also includes precast concrete unit pavers; PCC curb and gutter; HMA parking lot resurfacing; HMA recreational trail; PCC sidewalk; site electrical; sodding; and other incidental items in accordance with the contract

documents, including Plan File Nos. 519-034/084 on Riverwalk – North of Armory Building, Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated construction cost is \$1,386,901. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the City Engineer's Office.
