#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approval of grant agreements with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for funding of the City's First Year (2010) Action Plan of the 2010-2014 HUD Consolidated Plan.

### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend Council approval of grant agreements by and between HUD and the City of Des Moines, whereby the City will receive Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME) and Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) funding (grant awards) for the implementation of the First Year (period of January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2010) Action Plan of the 2010-2014 HUD Consolidated Plan.
