# **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approval of Economic Development Grant to the World Food Prize Foundation (WFPF), Kenneth Quinn, President, 666 Grand Avenue, Suite 1700, Des Moines, Iowa 50309.

# **SYNOPSIS:**

This action will approve a matching economic development grant and authorize the City Manager to provide a letter of financial commitment to the State of Iowa Vision Iowa Program on or before June 8, 2010 from the City of Des Moines to the WFPF in the amount of \$50,000.

The WFPF has received a communication from the State of Iowa Vision program indicating the City must make a cash contribution to the World Food Prize Project on or by June 9, 2010 in order to meet the terms and conditions of the Vision Iowa grant award for \$2 million to the World Food Prize. (The World Food Prize Project is performing extensive exterior and interior rehabilitation of the former central library property at 100 Locust Street for use as Dr. Norman E. Borlaug Hall of Laureates for meetings, educational functions and similar activities and the conversion of the adjacent surface parking lot to public gardens.)

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$50,000 Economic Development

<u>Funding Sources</u>: Economic Development Enterprise Account, CMO980717, SP473; other sources may be used to reimburse this account as they are identified.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The WFPF was awarded a \$2 million Vision Iowa contract in June 2009 with several conditions to be met before the funding could be released. These conditions required a dollar-for-dollar match of private funds to be raised by the WFPF, which has been satisfied, and a cash contribution from the City. The City previously indicated it would provide the financial contribution through waiver of the building permit fees which was accepted by Vision Iowa. Vision Iowa has now indicated that the waiver of these fees as a contribution is not acceptable. The WFPF says it will pay the building fees which are estimated to be about \$50,000.

The City is working with BRAVO Greater Des Moines, MD Isley, Executive Director, 1915 Grand Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa 50309, to provide a financial contribution to this Vision Iowa project; if the BRAVO funding is approved, it will be used to offset same or all of the funding provided through the Economic Development Enterprise account.
