SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of application as follows: Anawim Housing (Russ Frazier, President, 921 6th Avenue Suite B Des Moines, Iowa 50309) for Enterprise Zone benefits for a \$2.7 million project constructing 16 Apartment Units at 22nd Street and Forest Avenue in the Forest Avenue Enterprise Zone.

These are State of Iowa tax credits and have no impact on the general fund of the City of Des Moines. All are funded by the State of Iowa Enterprise Zone program.

\$22,000 Investment Tax Credit; \$27,000 Sales Tax Refund

The proposed housing project will assist with the overall Drake neighborhood revitalization effort, and provide quality affordable housing to individuals who had previously not been able to be served by Anawim. The goal of the project is to create a high quality multi-family rental development that is sensitive in design and use to the surrounding neighborhood. The project will provide infill development, as the units will be constructed on lots that are currently vacant. Construction is estimated to begin in fall 2010 and be completed by fall 2011.
