AGENDA HEADING:

Amending Chapter 114 of the Municipal Code regarding traffic regulation changes as follows:

- A. Parking Restriction—South Side of Willowmere Drive West of SW 61st Street
- B. Corner Clearance—West Side of 51st Street South of Grand Avenue
- C. Loading Zone Extension—West Side of 6th Avenue South of Grand Avenue

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Traffic and Transportation Division staff recommendations, including first reading of the Ordinance regarding the traffic regulation changes.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: Minor costs for signing modifications.

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2009-2010 Operating Budget, Page 93, Engineering Department Traffic & Transportation - Sign Installation and Maintenance, ENG100413.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

A. Local businesses along Willowmere Drive have requested that parking be prohibited along a section of the south side of the street to assist in the delivery of merchandise. Traffic and Transportation has reviewed this request and concurs. The following revision to the Municipal Code is necessary to place this parking restriction into effect.

Sec. 114-3778. Willowmere Drive—Dead end north of Park Plaza Drive to Southwest Sixty-third Street.

Willowmere Drive, on the south side, from a point 315 feet west of Southwest Sixty-first Street to a point 150 feet west thereof, no parking 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

B. Residents on 51st Street south of Grand Avenue have requested that the existing corner clearance parking restriction on the west side of the street be extended to provide more room for traffic to turn from Grand Avenue onto 51st Street. Traffic and Transportation has reviewed this request

and concurs. The following revision to the Municipal Code is necessary to place this parking restriction into effect.

Sec. 114-2943. Fifty-first Street—Welker Avenue to Aurora Avenue.

Fifty-first Street, on the west side, from Grand Avenue to a point 60 175 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

C. The developer of the new Hyatt Place extended stay hotel in the Liberty Building has requested that the existing Loading Zone on the west side of 6th Avenue be extended to provide an area long enough (48 feet) to accommodate two full-sized vehicles loading and unloading in front of the entrance of the hotel. Traffic and Transportation has reviewed this request and concurs. The following revision to the Municipal Code is necessary to place this extended Loading Zone into effect.

Sec. 114-2642. Sixth Avenue--Locust Street to Grand Avenue.

Sixth Avenue, on the west side, from a point 100 feet north of Locust Street to a point 105 123 feet north thereof, commercial loading zone.

Sixth Avenue, on the west side, from Locust Street to a point 205 223 feet north thereof, no parking 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 6:00p.m.

Sixth Avenue, on the west side, from Locust Street to a point 205 feet north thereof, no parking, 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Sixth Avenue, on the west side, from a point 205 223 feet north of Locust Street to Grand Avenue, no parking 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
