AGENDA HEADING:

Extension of Municipal Parking Facilities Management Services Agreement with Ampco System Parking.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the second one-year option period with Ampco System Parking for management services for the City's municipal parking facilities, in the amount of \$24,321 for the period from July 1, 2010, to June 30, 2011. On June 18, 2007, by Roll Call No. 07-1238, the City Council approved an agreement with Ampco System Parking for management services for the Municipal Parking Facilities for a period of two years, with an option to extend the contract for four additional one-year periods. The first option year of the agreement will expire on June 30, 2010, and it is in the City's best interest to extend the agreement with Ampco System Parking for the second one-year option period.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: The management agreement provides for a base management fee of \$22,000 per month for fiscal year 2007-08, with a monthly fee of \$15,210 for the Parking System and \$6,790 for the Park and Ride System, with subsequent year fees determined by the change in the Consumer Price Index for Urban Consumers (CPI-U) from the base CPI-U for May 2007. The May 2010 CPI is not scheduled to be released until June 17, so an estimate from the April 2010 data has been used to calculate the estimated fees for FY 2010-11. Based on the estimated CPI-U for May 2010, the monthly fee for the Parking System will be \$16,815 and \$7,506 for the Park & Ride System, for a total of \$24,321 per month (\$291,852 per year). The final fees will be based on the May CPI-U when it is released, as provided in the management agreement.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

In April of 2007, the City solicited proposals from companies interested in providing management services for the operation of the Municipal Parking Facilities. Proposals from three companies were received and evaluated. The selection subcommittee unanimously recommended Ampco System Parking as the preferred management company based on their overall parking experience; the experience of their proposed local General Manager, Sharon Lanies; customer service enhancement plan; revenue

enhancement plan; financial responsibility; and experience, knowledge and training on the new equipment and software for the Parking and Revenue Control System in the city garages. Ampco also had the lowest fee proposal, as well as the highest estimate annual revenues and annual net revenues.

On June 18, 2007, by Roll Call No. 07-1238, the City Council approved an agreement with Ampco System Parking for management services for the Municipal Parking Facilities for a period of two years, with an option to extend the contract for four additional one-year periods. During their previous years of operating the parking system, Ampco System Parking has performed very well and has gained valuable experience in making the operation of each individual garage efficient and effective. This experience has been enhanced because they have retained the same management team.
