## **AGENDA HEADING:**

Hearing on 2010 HMA Pavement Scarification & Resurfacing: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Grimes Asphalt & Paving Corp., J M Yonker, President, \$606,958.50.

## **SYNOPSIS:**

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2010 HMA Pavement Scarification & Resurfacing and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for timely maintenance of residential and arterial streets utilizing surface scarification and hot mix asphalt overlay to improve the surface condition and extend the useful service life of the streets.

## **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$606,958.50 Construction Contract (\$665,900 City Engineer's Estimate)

Funding Source: 2010-2011 CIP, Page Street-5, Asphaltic Paving Restoration Program, STR003, Being: \$50,086 in G. O. Bonds from STR003; \$437,330 in TIF-Backed G. O. Bonds from Downtown Area Street Restoration, STR075, Page Street-17; and \$119,542.50 in G. O. Bonds from Neighborhood Infrastructure Rehabilitation Program, STR205, Page Street-32

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On May 24, 2010, under Roll Call No. 10-781, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2010 HMA Pavement Scarification & Resurfacing. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2010 HMA Pavement Scarification & Resurfacing, 06-2010-013. The improvement includes scarification of two (2) inch average depth of asphalt street surfaces with specified milling machine and equipment in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines Public Works Department, all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations within the City of Des Moines:

Locust Street from 2nd Avenue to 6th Avenue Mulberry Street from 5th Street to 9th Street Penn Avenue from E. Locust Street to E. Grand Avenue Walnut Street from 12th Street to 15th Street.

Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:

Grimes Asphalt & Paving Corp., Grimes, IA OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Des Moines, IA

The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on June 15, 2010.

The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Grimes Asphalt & Paving Corp., J M Yonker, President, 12021 NW 54th Avenue, Grimes, IA, 50111 in the amount of \$606,958.50, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
