## **AGENDA HEADING:**

Ordering construction of the following: 2010 Park Playground Improvements - Receiving bids, (8-10-10), and Setting date of hearing, (8-23-10). (Construction Estimate - \$220,500).

#### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for the installation of new playground equipment, including curbing and poured in place resilient playground surfacing, at Drake Park. Also included in the project is new curbing and poured in place resilient playground surfacing around the rocket slide in Union Park. New sidewalks and ramps will be constructed to make these playground facilities handicapped accessible and improve access for all users.

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2010 Park Playground Improvements, 11-2010-010. The improvement includes the installation of modular playground equipment, resilient surfacing, PCC flatwork, earthwork and restoration; all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File Nos. 523-37/42 at Union Park, 725 Thompson Avenue, and Drake Park, 2300 Drake Park Avenue, located in Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated construction cost is \$220,500. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the City Engineer's Office.
