AGENDA HEADING:

Approving agreement with Project InVision International, Matt Meblin, Chief Executive Officer, 7428 Redwood Blvd., Suite 203, Novato, California 94945, to amend the terms of the Economic Development Loan Agreement.

SYNOPSIS:

On June 6, 2005, by Roll Call 05-1397, the City Council approved an Economic Development Loan with Project InVision International. The \$178,000 loan was to facilitate the software company's fast growth in Des Moines. The company had pledged to create at least 89 jobs with annual wages exceeding \$75,000. They reached peak employment of approximately 20 in 2006, but now have no employees in Des Moines and only 4 employees corporate-wide. The recession has resulted in a substantial reduction in their number of customers and a loss of nearly all license revenue. The company is on the verge of bankruptcy and is attempting to restructure its debts to remain a going concern.

Project InVision's outstanding loan balance is \$38,142.84. The company has proposed that the City forgive 50% (\$19,071.42) of the balance of its remaining obligation to the City and pay off the remaining \$19,071.42 on a 10-year payment scheduled at 0% interest. City staff recommends approval of these terms.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$19,071.42

<u>Funding Source:</u> Repayment is deposited in the Economic Development Enterprise Account, Fund SP743, Organization CMO980717.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Project InVision also received a \$700,000 CEBA Loan from the State of Iowa Department of Economic Development. The company has been granted a similar amendment to the repayment terms of the State loan balance.
