# AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of Amendment #3 to the FFY 2007 Homeland Security Grant Program Agreements.

## SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Amendment No. 3 to the original grant agreement which changes the performance period of FY2007 Homeland Security Grant Program Agreements. The approved performance period was from October 12, 2007 through May 15, 2010 and now has a new end date of December 31, 2010. The change in the end date will allow all work to be completed and all grant funds to be expended. There are no other changes to the grant other than the performance period end date.

# FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$820,000 (initial grant amount)

Explosive Ordinance Disposal (EOD) Task Force (\$480,000) and Weapons of Mass Destruction Tactical Officer's (SWAT) Task Force (\$340,000), with the City of Des Moines to share in the receipt of purchased equipment with the other task force members. There is no local match required for these grants.

<u>Funding Source</u>: U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Office of Grants and Training (OGT) FFY 2007 Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) allocation made to the State of Iowa. City of Des Moines operating budget: SP751, POL985303, page 255, (EOD); SP751, POL985313, page 255 (SWAT). Recommended Budget Fiscal Year Ending 2011.

# **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The Police Department will meet quarterly with the Task Force Leadership Committees to develop and approve equipment specifications within the requirements set forth in the state preparedness report, grant guidance and federal Approved Equipment List (AEL). The Police Department will meet with Iowa Homeland Security and Emergency Management to receive approval of the equipment specifications and to proceed with the equipment acquisitions.

The Police Department will coordinate purchases with the City's Finance Department in accordance with the City of Des Moines Purchasing Policies. The City of Des Moines will procure the equipment for all of Iowa's Explosive Ordinance Disposal (EOD) and Weapons of Mass Destruction Tactical Officer's (SWAT) Task Force Teams.
