AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of Amendment #3 to the FY2007 Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program (LETPP) Grant.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Amendment No. 3 to the original grant agreement which changes the performance period of the FY2007-LEIN5-05 Grant. The approved performance period was from October 12, 2007 through May 15, 2010 and now has a new end date of December 31, 2010. The change in the end date will allow all work to be completed and all grant funds expended. There are no other changes to the grant other than the performance period end date.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: The initial grant award from the State of Iowa Homeland Security and Emergency Management Division is \$316,667. There is no requirement for a local match.

Funding Source: Grant proceeds are deposited into SP751, POL980530, LETPP Grant (Page 255, Recommended Budget Fiscal Year Ending 2011).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The grant award is administered by the City of Des Moines for the 20 county area referred to as Law Enforcement Intelligence Network (LEIN) Region 5. The Des Moines Police Department was selected as one of six lead agencies throughout the State of Iowa to administer Federal Homeland Security Funds through LETPP. This is a continuation of a collaborative effort coordinated with other local, state and federal law enforcement agencies to share and analyze terrorism related intelligence data.

This amendment will allow for mandatory training to be completed and other expenses necessary and allowable to permit the LEIN Region 5 Fusion Center to operate.
