### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Hold hearing on the intent to acquire property for recreational trail purposes and authorize acquisition of the necessary property interests from various property owners for the Des Moines River Regional Trail Project by gift, negotiation, or eminent domain.

### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend authorization to acquire property for recreational trail purposes and authorize acquisition of the necessary property interests thereof from various property owners for the Des Moines River Regional Trail Project by gift, negotiation, or eminent domain. This action is required by Iowa law before the City can initiate the acquisition process under eminent domain.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$5,000 estimated acquisition plus closing costs

<u>Funding Source:</u> 2010-11 CIP, Park Improvements – Recreational Trails, PKS045, Page – Park

Improvements -20.

### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

This is a major regional trail that will ultimately connect downtown Des Moines to Carlisle and the Summerset Trail south of Carlisle. The first phase of this project is 2.5 miles stretching from the Meredith Trail at the Scott Street Bridge and following the south side of the Des Moines River to the James W. Cownie Soccer and Baseball Parks. Street connections into adjacent neighborhoods at SE 1<sup>st</sup>, SE 8<sup>th</sup>, SE 14<sup>th</sup> and SE 22<sup>nd</sup> Streets facilitate use of the trail by bicycle commuters from Des Moines' south side as well as recreational riders.

This will be a 10-foot wide asphalt recreational trail. Amenities on this trail will include lighting under bridges, mile markers, way-finding elements, trail signage and furniture, and river overlooks.

Two partial fee acquisitions will be needed for the first phase of this project. Relocation assistance will not be required.
