AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of document relating to urban renewal development agreement between the City of Des Moines and Merle Hay Mall Partnership LLC, Elizabeth I. Holland, Secretary, 3850 Merle Hay Road, Des Moines, IA 50314, for tax increment finance district grant payments.

SYNOPSIS:

Merle Hay Mall is in the process of obtaining a refinancing loan for its property at 3850 Merle Hay Road. As a condition of the refinancing, its bank, Well Fargo Bank, has required the City to execute a document relating to the payment of the tax increment finance grant.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Wells Fargo Bank, which is underwriting the refinancing loan for Merle Hay Mall, owned by the Merle Hay Mall Limited Partnership, is requiring execution of a document by the City relating to its bank loan for the Merle Hay Mall property.

In July 2008, the City entered into an urban renewal development agreement with the Merle Hay Mall Limited Partnership. As part of this agreement, the Mall must complete certain improvements and execute a minimum assessment agreement to increase the Mall's property tax assessment by at least \$10 million (to \$18 million) as a result of the improvements. Upon completion of those activities, the City will then make semi-annual payments (capped at \$400,000 annually) for fifteen years to the owners of Merle Hay Mall based on the property tax revenue from the Merle Hay Mall assessment and the availability of tax increment revenue in the Merle Hay Commercial Area tax increment finance district.

The mall owners have entered into a loan refinancing agreement with Well Fargo Bank, which is requiring execution of a document –"City Consent to Pledge" – that states the City will make the grant payments in accordance with the urban renewal agreement and if the property owner defaults, the City may make the TIF payments directly to the bank.
