AGENDA HEADING:

Resolution scheduling public hearing on proposed Annexation Moratorium Agreement and 28E Agreement with Pleasant Hill. (10-25-2010).

SYNOPSIS:

The cities of Des Moines and Pleasant Hill entered into an Annexation Moratorium Agreement in 2000 wherein the two cities have established a line of demarcation beyond which each city agreed not to annex for 10 years, being the maximum term allowed for such an agreement under Iowa Code §364.4. That agreement recently expired. The purpose of the proposed Annexation Moratorium Agreement and 28E Agreement is to renew and extend that agreement for another 10 year term.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: No immediate impact. Possible future savings from being able to better plan for the future growth of the city.

Funding Source: N/A

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The cities of Des Moines and Pleasant Hill have both exercised their authority under Iowa Code §354.9 to review subdivision plats and plats of survey for divisions or subdivisions in the unincorporated area within two miles of each city's respective boundary. This may occasionally result in one city being responsible for reviewing a plat located within the other city's expected growth area. A further purpose of the proposed new combined Annexation Moratorium Agreement and 28E Agreement is to require that any new plat located within 2 miles of both cities be reviewed by the city which expects to eventually contain the platted property, even though it may now be located closer to the other city.
