AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of 2010 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Formula Program: Local Solicitation grant award.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Des Moines Police Department's grant award from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance. The Des Moines Police Department will be using the funds to augment the 2009 JAG grant to assist in the design of electronic police report forms and implement an automated field reporting system as well as the purchase of 13 in-car digital audio/video recording systems to be placed in patrol vehicles. The Polk County Sheriff's office will be using the funds to purchase three in-car video recording systems for their patrol cars and the remaining funds will be used to purchase laptops and software for field investigators.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$298,857. There is no match requirement for this grant.

<u>Funding Source:</u> United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Formula Program. FY2011 Operating Budget, Page 255, Special Revenue Funds, SP751, POL984140.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The total award amount is \$298,857 with Des Moines allocated \$278,844 and the County of Polk allocated \$20,013. The City of Des Moines will act as fiscal agent for this grant award. Allocations are determined on a formula calculation based on a requirement that units of local government must have submitted to the FBI at least three years of Uniform Crime Report (UCR) data during the most-recent ten-year period for which UCR data are available in order to be eligible.

The grant period is from October 1, 2009 to September 30, 2013.
