AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of Amendment #1 to the FY2009 State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) National Infrastructure Protection Plan.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Amendment No. 1 to the original grant agreement which changes the performance period of the FY2009-SS-T9-0034-11 Grant. The approved performance period was from May 1, 2010 through March 31, 2010 and now has a **new start date of January 1, 2010**, to allow expenses incurred during that period to be eligible for reimbursement. There are no other changes to the grant other than the performance period start date.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: The grant award from the State of Iowa Homeland Security and Emergency Management Division is \$68,127. There is no requirement for a local match.

Funding Source: Grant proceeds are deposited into SP751, POL980550, HSGP Grant (Page 255, Recommended Budget for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2011.)

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The grant award is administered by the City of Des Moines for the 20 county area referred to as Law Enforcement Intelligence Network (LEIN) Region 5. The Des Moines Police Department was selected as one of six lead agencies throughout the State of Iowa to administer Federal Homeland Security Funds through SHSP. This is a continuation of a collaborative effort coordinated with other local, state and federal law enforcement agencies to share and analyze terrorism related intelligence data.
