SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Asbestos Removal at 717 Grand Avenue, former YWCA, and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. The project includes removal of asbestos containing materials at the former YWCA building prior to demolition.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On October 11, 2010, under Roll Call No. 10-1634, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Asbestos Removal at 717 Grand Avenue former YWCA. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Asbestos Removal at 717 Grand Avenue, former YWCA, 25-2011-005. The improvement includes removal of asbestos containing acoustic plaster, ceiling tile, floor tile, linoleum, thermal, insulation, and thermal system insulation and roofing materials; all in accordance with the contract documents at the former YWCA
